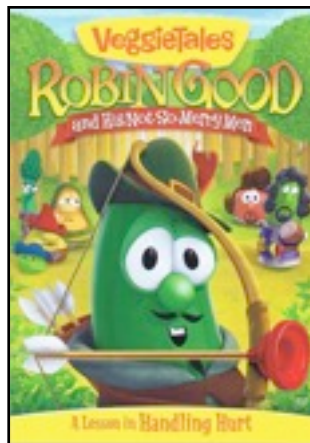
What is Ekklesia?
